CONNECT (10 MIN)

In the beginning of his sermon, Pastor Joe mentioned that it can be much easier to complain (either internally or out loud) about bad service in a restaurant or a store than to call out and thank someone for exceptional service. Can you think of a time when someone went out of their way to thank you or appreciate you? What was that like, and how did it make you feel?

Study & Discussion (25 min)

- Read Exodus 15:2, 13, and 17. How are these verses about God's character made evident in the events of Exodus that we've examined so far? How are they made evident in the person and work of Jesus Christ later on?
- Read Deuteronomy 6:12 and 8:2.
 - Why is it important for us to "remember to remember" the ways that God has molded and shaped us into His likeness, the ways He has drawn us to Him, in the events of our lives?
 - What are some circumstances in your past that you know God has used to reveal Himself to you?
 - How have those circumstances helped you to trust in God more deeply and fully?
- Joe mentioned 5 statements about God in his sermon (see below). Which of these statements is easiest for you to understand and trust in? Which is most difficult, and why?
 - Yahweh stands alone is God
 - He is awe-inspiringly perfect
 - He is all-powerful and just
 - He is overflowing in covenant-keeping love
 - He is a Savior
